Presidents Report- Morgan

Fun Run - Big thank yous to all who helped make Fun Run a big success. Special call out to Rachel for pounding the pavement getting a record number of sponsors. Also to Heather for coordinating the many volunteers, the Staff for supporting all of our efforts . Thank you to our community for what we have accomplished. \$91k earned in a short 2 weeks.

Prizes - October 11 PAC will be assembling the prizes. Prizes should be distributed by Oct 14, depending on shipping.

Need to create a raffle for Blazer tickets and for Langers.

Prize idea for next year: The Hustler Award! - Give the student whose sponsor envelope is well marked up with lots of different donors. This student worked hard to support our school. They could be awarded a Mudpuddles gift card.

Nov 6 - Dance party. Gym has been reserved. Krispy Kreme offers a reduced price for 501c3s. Need to borrow music (same as fun run). Order glow sticks.

Need lighting; black lights. There will be some areas with low lighting so the glow sticks will be fun. But, overall will be pretty bright so we can supervise. Need volunteers.

SkyHigh - Nov 19. Their price went up \$1900 (from \$1700 last year). All inclusive, drinks, popcorn. Bring a friend. Put permission slip in prize bag. Need to work on logistics on getting all permission slips in a timely manner.

Financial- Amy

Fun Run - \$90,000 goal. Sponsorships collected. about \$10,000 (double what we normally get). \$77,000 pledges in-hand. The rest are pledges that are promised to come in and \$2600 of company matches that may not be collected for a few years.

Expense spent \$7400 prizes, t-shirts, misc. A lot out standing because of bonus t-shirts, sky high \$1900, Pledgestar \$1000, printing costs, dance party costs.

Our net is \$76,000 (last year about \$72,000). Last year we gave \$75/ student back to teachers which exceeded previous years. Library, PE , ESL, sound systems. retained \$8700 for normal budgeting items: Oregon Trail, Biz Town, etc..

Ideas for this year's funds:

Melissa Parmalee has volunteered to head a playground revamp committee. Parents, students, and teachers have been asking for this. How can we incrementally improve the playground over the next several years?

Water filtration system - month long install. Getting water bottle fillers around the school. What grants can help us?

We want to spend the money this calendar year so students can enjoy the benefits of their hard work.
